



Saint Martin of Tours

He was born in a place called Savaria, now in Hungary, in the year 318. His father was a senior officer in the Imperial Horse Guards of the Roman Army. Martin also joined the Roman army and was deployed in Gaul (modern day France).

When he was still in the army, he accidentally met a beggar with a scant dress. Due to pity on that beggar, Martin cut his own military cloak into half and gave one half to that beggar. But in that night Martin saw a dream in which Jesus was wearing the half cloak he gave the beggar and telling the angels “Here is Martin, the Roman soldier not yet baptized but he has clad me”. In another story, when Martin woke up, his cloak was restored. He was then baptized at the age of 18 years. He left the army saying, “I am a soldier of Christ, I cannot fight”. He became Bishop of Tours in the year 371. He died on November 8, 397. His cloak became the most sacred relic of the Frankish Kings, and the kings took the cloak wherever they went.

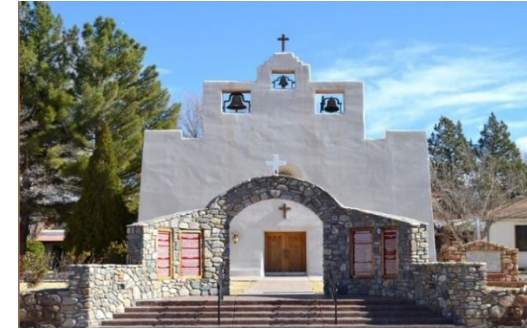
